SUMMER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

Study abroad in a South American country renowned for its stunning natural beauty, vibrant culture, and fascinating history! This program is based in Santiago, a cosmopolitan city surrounded by soaring mountain peaks and fertile valleys. The coursework will explore Chilean history and culture in relationship to the broader history of Latin America. Students will grapple with questions such as why Chile's economy is the most prosperous and stable in the region while at the same time it continues to face the high levels of inequality characteristic of Latin America as a whole. Visits to a diverse array of cultural and historical sites and excursions to different cities within the country will allow for experiential learning and connect what is studied inside the classroom to life outside.
