

## **SUMMER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM**

As the capital of Anjou and gateway to the Loire Valley, Angers is distinguished for the richness of its heritage and its cultural and economic dynamism. Angers' metropolitan population of 260,000 is home to more than 30,000 students, and the town is located equidistant from Paris (less than two hours by high-speed train) and the Atlantic Ocean. The towers of the nearby castle fortress guard over the town and its museums, gardens, shops, restaurants, art festivals, and student life. Students attend intensive language courses at the Université Catholique de l'Ouest (UCO) and live with French host families. Organized evening activities and weekend excursions with students from all over the world who are also studying in Angers add to the immersion experience.

Students must enroll in 6 credit hours.
