SUMMER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

To experience more of this beautiful, geographically and culturally diverse country, students will first spend a week in Lima on the central coast of the country, where they can enjoy beautiful beaches, parks, and the central market. Students will then spend three weeks in Cusco, the capital of the Incan Empire. This immersion program combines intensive language and conversation courses with two organized cultural activities per week (Peruvian cuisine, Pisco tasting, and visits to the Sacred Valley and a pre-Incan archaeological site, for example) and weekend excursions to Machu Picchu (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) and Lake Titicaca. Students attend language classes during the day and stay with Peruvian host families to experience total immersion in the language and culture.
